

MAGC Genetic Counseling Services Committee Chair Responsibilities

The Genetic Counseling Services (GCS) Committee Chair has responsibilities as both a Board member and Committee Chair. As a MAGC Board member, the GCS Chair is expected to:

1. Attend or participate in all meetings and conference calls of the Board of Directors (BOD).
2. Provide periodic reports of the GCS committee activities to the BOD.
3. Submit an annual GCS committee budget to the Treasurer.
4. Carry out activities that the BOD deems appropriate.
5. Participate in BOD activities and functions including discussions and votes concerning the overall operations of the organization.

The GCS Committee is responsible for issues related to the provision of genetic counseling services in the state of Michigan. The GCS Committee has conducted state-wide surveys related to billing and reimbursement, professional status, and mentorship. It is anticipated that these will be ongoing projects for this committee, with regular surveying of the genetic counselors in the state. The committee will also work on issues that are deemed reasonable that are suggested by the membership and/or BOD.
