

MAGC President Responsibilities

As defined in the Corporations bylaws, the President serves as the Chairperson of the Board and shall be the chief executive officer of the corporation and shall preside at all meetings of the members and of the Board of Directors at which the President is present. The President shall see that all orders and resolutions of the Board of Directors are carried into effect, and shall have the general powers of supervision and management usually vested in the chief executive officer of a corporation. The President shall also have the general powers of supervision and management over the day-to-day operations of the corporation.

Expected duties:

- When present, Preside at meetings of the board and of the membership.
- Develop agendas for meetings of the BOD and of the membership with input from the BOD
- Have general active management of the business of the organization with input from the BOD
- Represent the organization in internal and external activities and relationships, or appoint a representative
- See that decisions and resolutions of the board are carried into effect
- See that procedures defined in bylaws are carried into effect
- Perform other duties prescribed by the board
